# Permitting Authority

- Part IV - Chapter 373, F.S. – *Authority*
- Chapter 62-330, F.A.C. – *Interprets Statute*
- Applicant's Handbook I and II – *Design Standards*

# Environmental Resource Permit ( ERP)

- Gives authorization for construction and operation of surface water management systems.





# Conditions for Permit Issuance

- The review process of an ERP ensures that the permit will authorize activities that are not harmful to the water resources or are inconsistent with the public interest.
- This includes floodplain encroachment and appropriate compensation analysis.

# 100-Year Flood Level Determinations

Determined using most accurate information available:

1. Actual data, including water level, stream flow and rainfall records;
2. Hydrologic/hydraulic modeling;
3. Federal Flood Insurance Rate Maps and supporting flood study data; or
4. Floodplain analysis studies.

# Floodplain Encroachment

- No net encroachment into the flood plain, up to that encompassed by the 100-year event, which will adversely affect conveyance, storage, water quality or adjacent lands will be allowed.
